

CCGRRRA10 — Survival guide

Conference format

The conference opens at 5:00pm on Wednesday May 28 with a **welcoming reception at the University Club**. The University Club is located on the 5th floor of the University Centre. Registration will take place during the reception, which will conclude at 8:00pm. Snack food and drinks will be available.

The conference proper begins on Thursday May 29. Morning sessions will be devoted to invited talks, while afternoon sessions will be devoted to contributed talks.

The morning sessions will take place in **room 105 of the MacNaughton building** (which houses the Department of Physics). Coffee will be served at 8:30am and the talks will begin at 9:00am. Coffee will be served again at 10:00am, and the lunch break will begin at 12:30pm.

The afternoon sessions will be held in parallel in **MacNaughton 105 and in room 103 of the University Centre**. They will start at 2:00pm and continue until late in the afternoon. The afternoon coffee break will take place at 3:30pm.

All coffee breaks will be held in the foyer of the MacNaughton building.

The **conference banquet** will take place on Friday, May 30, at the Whippetree (4th floor of the University Centre). It begins at 7:00pm.

The conference ends at 2:00pm on Saturday, May 31.

Computer access

Personal computers with internet and telnet access are located in **rooms 315 and 317 of the MacNaughton building**. These computers can all be used freely without a user account.

Login instructions are posted at each station.

To use **Netscape** simply double-click on the 'Netscape' icon after logging on to the computer.

To use **telnet** follow these instructions:

1. Double-click on the 'Student Accounts' icon.
2. Double-click on 'Telnet UofG.'
3. Click on the 'Connect' button, then pull to 'Disconnect'.
4. Click on the 'Connect' button, then pull to 'Remote System'.
5. Enter the hostname of the machine you wish to access, and click on 'Connect'.
6. Enter your userid and password.

It is necessary to go through operations 3 and 4 because the software anticipates a connection to the University's mainframe computer. It is therefore necessary to disconnect first, and then connect to the desired remote system.

Lunch on and off campus

The easiest and closest place to get lunch is the **Centre Six Food Court** inside the **University Centre**. There you'll find a fairly broad selection of meals, at a price that's unfortunately a bit inflated.

To avoid long lineups at the Centre Six, conference participants are encouraged to be adventurous and go a little further afield to get lunch. Alternative lunch places include:

The Brass Taps Lounge: This is located on the 2nd floor of the University Centre, and you can access it directly from the main lobby. They serve standard pub-type food, which is reasonably good. And they have beer!

The Grad lounge: This is located on the 5th floor of the University Centre. Their food selection is a bit limited, but they have good curries. And beer!

The Gryphs Sports Lounge: This is located on the second floor of the Gryphon Centre, which is directly opposite the Athletics Centre and a very short walk east of the University Centre. Pub food. And beer! If you're lucky you'll get to watch a hockey game while you eat.

Portly Penguin; Good Taste; Shakespeare Arms: These eating establishments are all located at Campus Estates, a strip mall opposite the UofG campus (and the Ramada Inn) at the corner of Harvard and Gordon. This is a bit of a longer walk (about 10 minutes), but there you'll find real restaurants. Shakespeare Arms is a very good pub; I believe they have beer.

Going downtown

To get dinner you are strongly encouraged to go downtown, where you'll find many restaurants that offer a broad selection of specialties in the whole range of the price spectrum.

To walk downtown takes approximately 30 minutes. It is mainly downhill on the way there from campus, and mostly downhill on the way back if you walk backwards. As you cross the Speed river you can visit the Boathouse for their excellent ice-cream, which you can eat on top of the pedestrian wooden bridge while you admire the view (mostly ducks).

If you don't feel like walking you can catch the downtown bus (route #52) at the back (southern end) of the University Centre. The bus leaves every 30 minutes, either on the hour or at the half hour. You can get off the bus at St.-George's Square, the end of its route. The return bus leaves St.-George's Square every thirty minutes (at a quarter to or a quarter after the hour). The bus fare is \$1.85 (each way) in exact change. Tickets can be purchased at the Information Desk of the University Centre.

Here's a list of recommended downtown restaurants:

Wok's Taste: 16 Carden Street. The best Chinese restaurant in town. Inexpensive.

Carden Street Cafe: 40 Carden Street. Their menu is largely Asian inspired, with many very good curries. Inexpensive; arguably the best ratio quality/price in Guelph.

Babel Fish Bistro: 80 MacDonell Street. A very inventive menu and a great atmosphere. Fairly expensive, but not overpriced. This should not be confused with the restaurant at the end of the universe, which is located on the other side of MacDonell Street.

Latino's: 51 Cork Street. A very good latin american restaurant. Great margaritas, but you didn't get this from me. Fairly inexpensive.

Sushi Choice: 45 Cork Street. I like it. Not too expensive for sushi.

Curry in a Hurry: 9 Cork Street. They have a good selection of Indian curries, and they are quite good. Inexpensive.

Diana: 141 Wyndham Street. This is essentially a family restaurant, but their East Indian menu is very good. You must try their coconut chicken. Fairly inexpensive.

Woolwich Arms: 176 Woolwich Street. A good pub. Inexpensive, but that depends on how many pints you have.

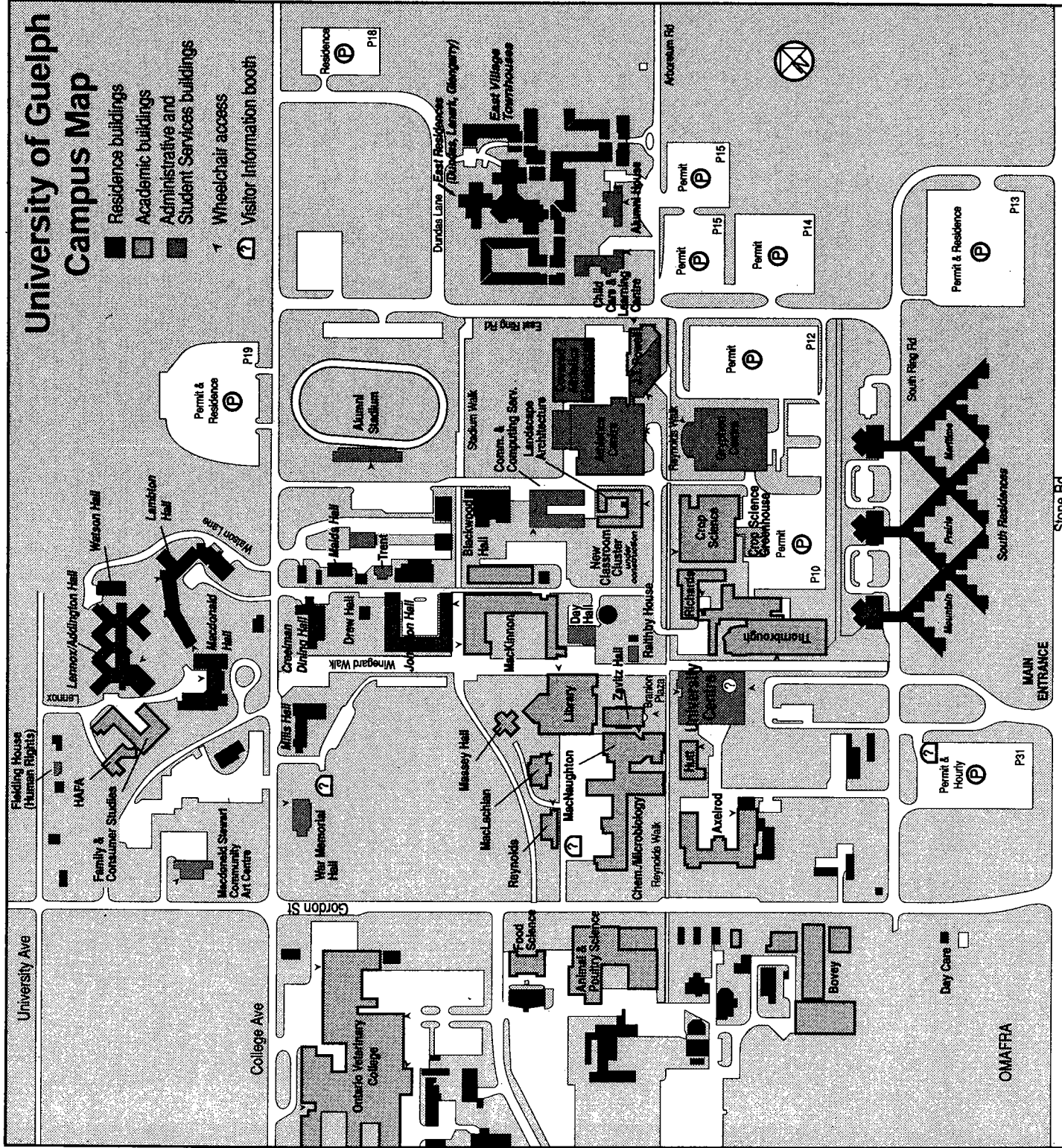

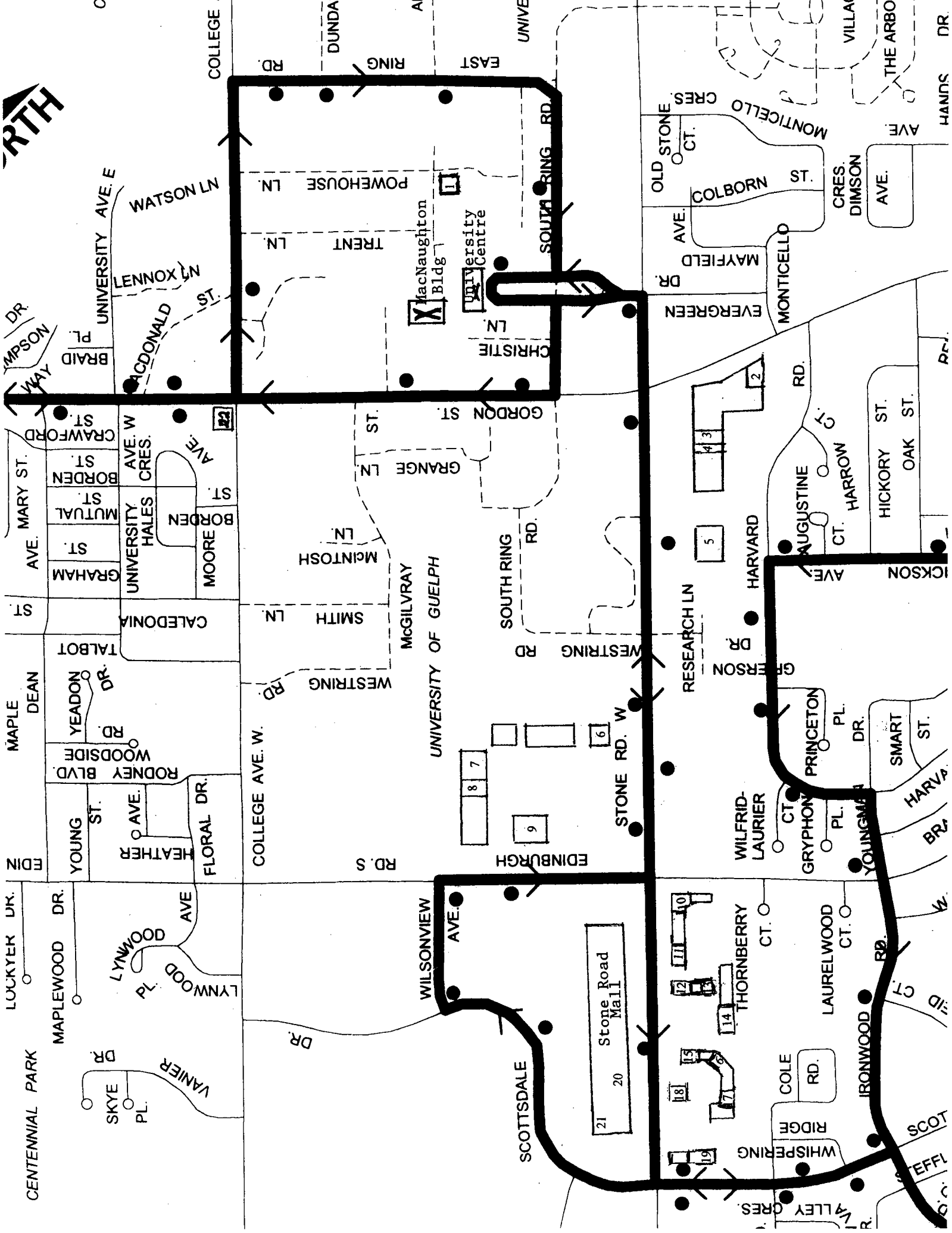
